Guidelines for Setting up the "Chair in Memory of Mr. Ku-Hsiung Liu"

Approved by No. 268 College Affairs Meeting on October 25, 2021

- Article 1. To encourage the young talents, the family of Mr. Ku-Hsiung Liu invites outstanding foreign scholars to give lectures and engage in academic research in order to cultivate talents in the fields of bioresources and agricultural sciences. The Liu family hereby sets up the "Chair in Memory of Mr. Ku-Hsiung Liu" (hereinafter referred to as the Chair) in the College of Bioresources and Agriculture, National Taiwan University (hereinafter referred to as the College).
- **Article 2.** The Chair is to reward top foreign scholars who are under the age of 65 and meet one of the following qualifications for short-term employment or exchange in each department (unit) of the College:
 - (1) Not currently full-time teaching or research staff in academic research institutes in Taiwan.
 - (2) Worked in a foreign university or research institute for five years prior to the date of application.
- **Article 3**. One person for the Chair will be awarded an annual grant of NT\$ 400,000.
- Article 4. The College shall organize a Review Committee, which is responsible for reviewing and selecting the Chair. The aforementioned Committee consists of five to seven members. The Dean of the College invites experts and scholars from inside and outside the university to serve as the members. After the applicant department (unit) submits the candidate's information, this will be forwarded to the Committee for review and selection.
- Article 5. The Chair lasts for one year. The recipient is required to hold a

seminar course, and to organize a symposium, inviting several experts in the field of agriculture to present technology-related lectures.

- **Article 6**. In the course of the duty, the Chair can apply for other, related funds.
- **Article 7.** These Guidelines are promulgated after being approved by the College Affairs Meeting.
